Tennis Outreach Programs (TOPs) is celebrating another year of your outstanding dedication to affordable youth tennis.

Your commitment to our nonprofit's mission of **empowering youth for lifetime success through tennis, education, fitness and character development regardless of economic circumstance** carried us through a year of record-setting demand for registrations of our youth programs, increased community engagement through outreach events, and the resumption of our foundational in-school programming at local elementary schools.

Each week, we welcome hundreds of energetic youth players into our facility to work with our USTA and USPTA trained coaches to develop skills, build confidence and engage in healthy exercise. **This year we served more than 2,500 unique youth players!**

Our home at Eastside Tennis Center allows us to offer multiple ways for families of all income levels to take part in our programs. With a low-cost annual access pass, we offer both weekday and weekend classes to support a variety of families' schedules. **More than 35% of available court time at ETC is reserved for our students.**

At TOPs, we use tennis and the principles of sports-based youth development to build a community of youth, and adults who work, learn and play together.

With your support, we will continue tackling the disparities in our community by providing high quality tennis, as well as life-skills, and outreach activities in collaboration with other non-profit organizations. **We aim to develop and support the physical and social-emotional health of the youth we serve.**

Last year, Tennis Outreach Programs awarded \$30,678.00 in financial assistance. TOPs offers subsidized and complete financial assistance to applicants as needed. Our **online financial aid application** is available to the general public and is an easy way for families to request programs and access pass assistance discreetly. We also offer free tennis racquets, shoes and clothing to kids of all ages with support from tennis brands, community donations and our own equipment offerings.

We invite you to see our mission in action. Stop by ETC weekday afternoons between 3-7pm to see the impact of tennis on the whole child. We hope you'll be inspired and help us grow our nonprofit's reach!

# Juanita & Frost Elementary Schools

In FY22 TOPs resumed our foundational outreach programs in Kirkland, Washington through partnerships with Juanita Schools Foundation and Robert Frost Elementary. 


## Total Revenue FY 2022
